Summary of A/AS results

Year 13

120 boys were entered for 319 A level exams of which 97.8% were passed at A-E level. This is equal to last year's achievement and just above the national average. Most pleasingly there was an increase of 8% at A-C level with an A-C pass rate of 68% and an increase of 2% at A-B level to 37% A-B grades. This returns the boys results to their highest ever level.

A further 8 boys completed Applied A levels successfully.

There were, as usual, some outstanding results including Tautvydas Sutkus (4 A grades), Peter Apps (3 A grades) and Usama Maayuf (3 A grades)

Over 90% of students will be attending university including 4 boys who achieved places at medical schools.
